

Inclusiveness Policy

No sexism, racism, discrimination or any kind of exclusion will be tolerated in association with Juice Box Jam and we reserve the right to refuse and/or remove content based on our principles. We encourage inclusive and welcoming environments. We encourage free and open activity where creativity should know no censorship and we hope all participants will exercise their creative freedoms. Juice Box Jam is not liable for anyone's specific views and opinions.

Code of Conduct

Purpose

Juice Box Jam focuses on educating and creating a safe environment for creators to try their hand at making kids games through collaboration, innovation and experimentation. We are committed to providing a friendly, safe, and welcoming environment for all, regardless gender, sexual orientation, ability, appearance, ethnicity, national origin, citizenship, socioeconomic status, and religion (or lack thereof).

This code of conduct outlines our guidelines for all those who participate in our jam as well as consequences for unacceptable behavior.

Appropriate Behavior

We ask participants to exercise consideration and respect in their speech and actions, attempt collaboration before conflict, and refrain from demeaning, discriminatory, or harassing behavior and speech. We expect the same consideration and respect be applied to games and content created at Juice Box Jam.

Be mindful of your surroundings and of your fellow participants. Alert staff immediately if you notice a dangerous situation, someone in distress or violations of this Code of Conduct even if they seem inconsequential.

Unacceptable Behavior

Unacceptable behaviors include: intimidating, harassing, abusive, discriminatory, derogatory or demeaning speech or actions by any participant at jam locations, online or any related event locations. This includes one on one communications in public or private, off and online. If event space is shared with public be respectful to all patrons of these locations.

Harassment includes: harmful or prejudice verbal or written comments related to gender, sexual orientation, age, ability, appearance, ethnicity, national origin, citizenship, socioeconomic status, or religion; deliberate intimidation, stalking or following; harassing photography or recording;

sustained disruption of talks or other events; inappropriate physical contact; and unwelcome sexual attention.

Consequences of Unacceptable Behavior

Anyone asked to stop unacceptable behavior is expected to comply immediately.

If a participant engages in unacceptable behavior, staff may take action to stop behavior up to and including permanent expulsion from the jam without warning (and without refund).

If you witness or are subject to unacceptable behavior

If you are subject to or witness unacceptable behavior or have any other concerns please notify staff as soon as possible or submit a notice through this form (can be submitted anonymously).

Addressing Grievances

If you feel you have been falsely or unfairly accused of violating this Code of Conduct you should notify staff with a concise description of your grievance.

Scope

All participants (contributors, paid or otherwise; sponsors; and other guests) to abide by this Code of Conduct during all Juice Box Jam events - online and in person - as well as in all one on one group communications pertaining to jam business.

Content Policy

Juice Box Jam is about learning, experimenting, sharing, collaboration and teaching each other. Participants are expected to share their games by uploading their games, assets, source code etc.

Games are uploaded under the [Attribution-NonCommercial-ShareAlike 4.0 Creative Commons license](#).

This means the team that created the game, owns the original content and can do with it as they please, and Juice Box Jam retains an original copy that other people can download, modify and distribute for non-commercial purposes.

All files necessary to run the game, as well as all assets, source code and project files created during Juice Box Jam and necessary to build/compile and link the game from scratch must be uploaded as well. Third party tools, libraries, engines and assets that are used for the games, but not created during the Juice Box Jam may be omitted from the submission. However clear instructions must be included on how to purchase or obtain these resources in order to continue development on the game.

Juice Box Jam reserves the right to remove any uploaded games if the content is offensive or unsuitable. This includes but is not limited to: games with harmful or prejudicial themes related to gender, sexual orientation, age, ability, appearance, ethnicity, national origin, citizenship, socioeconomic status, or religion. Privacy Policy

Policy for Email Usage (general)

Juice Box Jam respects its participants privacy. We will never sell or share participants email for purpose of profit to any third party organizations. Emails will not be shared with unrelated third-parties or affiliates other than what is explicitly stated below. The email list will only be shared internally and used for general communication and event announcements.

Juice Box Jam may share your email address with third parties to enable Juice Box Jam to take security measures to help protect against unauthorized access to or unauthorized alteration, disclosure or destruction of data. Finally Juice Box Jam may share email addresses with third parties necessary to perform certain services on our behalf, such as packaging, mailing and delivering products and processing event services and respond to your service requests.

General communications of email:

Once collected, we may use your email in a variety of ways including but not limited to:
